Strutmount Sizing and Dimensions

There are two things to always take into consideration regarding the size and dimensions of your mounts:

First you need to consider the size of the insert (i.e. the photograph or print).

Note, the actual size of the aperture (or hole) will always be slightly smaller than the print itself otherwise it will fall out. Just remember that usually the print size is given and not the true aperture size i.e. a 4x6" mount or folder is for 4x6" size prints. This space is usually about 0.25 inches smaller on all edges.

Consider the outside dimensions of the mount or folder.

You'll need to know the outside dimensions to determine the dimensions of the packaging you are going to use. The bag you are going to use must always be a little bigger than the mount or folder (see table below).

If you plan on putting the mount or folder into a frame then obviously you'll need to know the exact outer dimensions of your mount or folder as well.
